



# Instructions & Guidelines



## BATCHES: KIDS BATCH/ SUB JUNIORS:

- 🔔 Parents are requested to drop their kids in class 10 minutes before the start of the batch and frequently Coming Late to class will not be encouraged.
- 🔔 Students are required to be punctual and maintain discipline in class.
- 🔔 Parents, please ensure to send your kids in neatly dressed, ironed **DANCE UNIFORM** with Dupatta tied to their waist for both Girls and Boys.
- 🔔 Girls should apply a visible Bindi.
- 🔔 Girls should tie their Hair in either two or one plaits and girls with short hair must wear a Hair band to prevent hair falling into their eyes and on the floor.
- 🔔 Make sure kids go to the Washroom at Home and then come to class.
- 🔔 Send their Water Bottles and napkins and remember to carry them back while returning from class.

## BATCHES: JUNIORS/ SENIORS:

- 🔔 Students are to be punctual and be present in class 10 minutes before the batch.
- 🔔 Frequent latecomers will be sent home after 3 warnings.
- 🔔 Students should dress up neatly in **Kalakshetra Practice Sari** with properly pinned and tied their pallus effective from 10th July 2024. No sleeveless blouses allowed.
- 🔔 Students should apply a **Visible Bindi**, and wear bangles and earrings, hair should be tied up properly, and no free/ loose hairs to the class.
- 🔔 Mobile phones must be in Silent Mode and to be used only to call the parents before finishing the class to pick them up Students should practice or watch their fellow mates while dancing and not meddle with their phones.



## GENERAL

- 🔔 Any leaves, other than a Sick/ emergency need to be informed well in advance to Sir or Ma'am
- 🔔 Any doubts regarding dance to be clarified in class with Sir or Ma'am.
- 🔔 Dance class is to be **Treated as a temple** as its learning place for art, hence please ensure to maintain the cleanliness and DO NOT damage the class premises
- 🔔 Upcoming Programs/ Competitions to be discussed in class or personally with Sir & Ma'am
- 🔔 Dance Fees to be paid on Time
